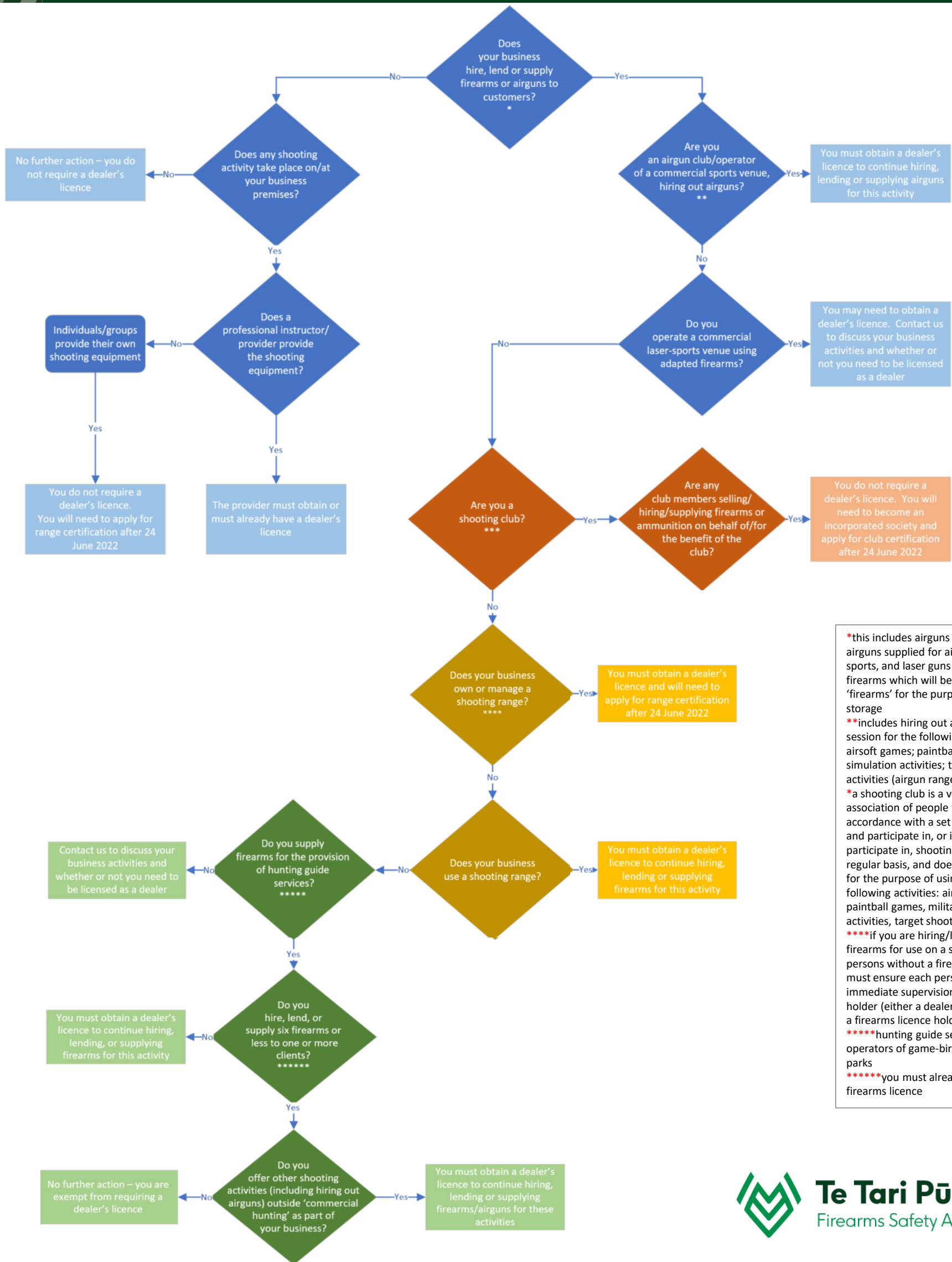


# Dealer decision matrix

Do I need a dealer's licence as a shooting experience provider?



\*this includes airguns and restricted airguns supplied for airsoft or paintball sports, and laser guns derived from firearms which will be treated as 'firearms' for the purposes of secure storage

\*\*includes hiring out airguns for a session for the following activities: airsoft games; paintball games; military simulation activities; target shooting activities (airgun range operator)

\*a shooting club is a voluntary association of people who act in accordance with a set of written rules; and participate in, or intend to participate in, shooting activities on a regular basis, and does not include a club for the purpose of using airguns in the following activities: airsoft games, paintball games, military simulation activities, target shooting with airguns

\*\*\*if you are hiring/lending/supplying firearms for use on a shooting range to persons without a firearms licence, you must ensure each person is under the immediate supervision of a licence holder (either a dealer or staff who hold a firearms licence holder)

\*\*\*\*\*hunting guide services include operators of game-bird or animal game parks

\*\*\*\*\*you must already hold a standard firearms licence
