

Application by a licensed dealer for approval to manufacture certain classes of arms items

Arms Act 1983, Section 6B

1. Use this form to apply for the Commissioner's approval to manufacture for supply any items in the following classes of arms item:
 - » pistols,
 - » restricted weapons,
 - » pistol carbine conversion kits,
 - » air pistol carbine conversion kits.
2. You must apply for and have received written approval before beginning the manufacture for supply of any items of these classes.
3. You must already hold a dealer's licence that authorises you to carry on the activity of manufacturing, or be applying for a dealer's licence including the activity of manufacturing.
4. An approval to manufacture the arms items listed in this application, if granted, will be subject to the condition that the items are manufactured before the expiry date of your dealer's licence. You will need to submit a new application when applying to renew your dealer's licence to continue manufacturing the listed classes of arms item.
5. For pistols, restricted weapons, or pistol carbine conversion kits you must set out the special reasons why the items you propose to manufacture should be in New Zealand.
6. For air pistol carbine conversion kits, you must provide information so that Police can be satisfied that the item(s) are being manufactured for the personal use of a member of an airsoft or paintball club affiliated to a national airsoft or paintball organisation.
7. You may supply documentation regarding the arms items to support your application. You could attach a copy of the technical specifications of the arms item. This may include an 'exploded diagram' (graphic) and/or photograph(s).
8. Approval will be subject to any conditions specified by the Commissioner's delegate approving the application.
9. Approval is subject to Police being satisfied that:
 - » there are special reasons why pistol, restricted weapon or pistol carbine conversion kit items proposed to be manufactured should be in New Zealand,
 - » in the case of air pistol carbine conversion kits that the kits are for the personal use of a person who is a member of an airsoft or paintball club affiliated to a national airsoft or paintball organisation (see s6B(4)),
 - » the dealer's licence includes the necessary dealer activity with the appropriate class(es) of arms items,
 - » the dealer holds the appropriate endorsement(s) for the class(es) of arms items to be manufactured, and
 - » the security of the place of business in respect of which the approval is sought will be sufficient.
