

# Application for consent to conduct a gun show from a different place of business

## Arms Act 1983, Section 7A

1. A licensed dealer who wishes to hold a gun show from a place of business other than the usual place of business specified in their dealer's licence must apply for and receive consent to conduct the gun show before the commencement of the gun show event (s7A).
2. Gun shows include, but are not limited to, auctions away from your place of business, or the display of or sales or taking orders for arms items from a stand or display booth at an arms exhibition or arms related conference.
3. The maximum duration for a gun show is five days.
4. Consent will be subject to any conditions specified by the commissioned officer of Police approving the application.
5. The commissioned officer deciding whether to give consent needs to be satisfied:
  - » that the licensed dealer will, during the period in respect of which the consent is sought, use the place of business in respect of which the consent is sought only for the purposes of conducting a gun show, and
  - » that suitable management control and procedures are implemented at the licensed dealer's normal place of business if the premises will be open during the gun show, and
  - » that the security of the place of business in respect of which the gun show consent is sought will be sufficient.

The information provided is collected for the purpose of administration of the Arms Act 1983. NZ Police will hold, store, use or disclose the personal information collected in accordance with the provisions of the Privacy Act 2020. This means that, where necessary, NZ Police may use or disclose your personal information to enable it to carry out its lawful functions, including prevention, detection, investigation and prosecution of offences.
