# Notes for applicants

## Notes 1 and 2:

Capacities and types of items for which endorsements may be granted in those capacities

Endorsements may be granted for certain items in particular capacities. State which one of the following capacities that applies to you and the item you seek to possess. You need to have the corresponding endorsement before the permit to possess can be issued.

#### Note 3: Reason for acquisition

Explain why you are seeking to add this item to your endorsement. For example, collectors might explain why it would fit in with and enhance their collection; a film production company might require a particular item for an upcoming film.

### Note 4: Facts demonstrating why it is appropriate to possess the prohibited firearm or prohibited magazine

A person seeking to possess a prohibited firearm or prohibited magazine also needs to set out sufficient information here (perhaps supplemented by further documents that might be attached) to explain why it is appropriate for them to possess the prohibited firearm or prohibited magazine with reference to their capacity as an exempt person under section 4A of the Act. For example, a person employed by DoC may explain how their existing prohibited magazine is worn and they need to acquire another to replace it. It is appropriate to demonstrate why a non-prohibited firearm or magazine cannot be used for the purpose.
