
Transporting firearms to hunting locations

A safer process for checking your firing zone BACKGROUND **IDENTIFY THE** SIGHTS TARGET

Identify and observe the area behind your target and ensure it is free of people/vehicles/buildings/ stock and that it's suitable for the range and trajectory of the firearm you are using. Identify your target beyond all doubt and ensure the immediate area around it is clear. Place the sights on the target.

Safety tip: Always unload and secure your firearm when you have finished using it.
