Thank you for your Official Information Act 1982 (OIA) requests dated 22 January 2026 and refinement of your request received 29 January 2026. I have answered each of your questions below:

For the period 1 July 2021 to 31 December 2025, please provide the total number of firearms licence holders who have been subject to temporary suspension, licence revocation, endorsement removal or revocation, and referral to Resolutions for consideration of revocation. Of those individuals, please provide the number who subsequently came to Police attention after the regulatory action for any criminal offending, violent offending, family harm incidents, and firearms-related offending. This request is for aggregated statistical data only and does not seek any identifying personal information.

The total number of licence holders that have been revoked, suspended, and considered for revocation is based on the date a licence status has been updated to a suspended or revoked status. Endorsement revocations are based on the date an endorsement is updated to a revoked status.

When a licence holder is referred to Resolutions for consideration of suspension and revocation a 'considering suspension' firearms event is created in the National Intelligence Application (NIA). The provided figures includes any suspensions, revocations, and considerations of suspension that have occurred between 1 July 2021 and 31 December 2025.

Licence holders may have had multiple changes to their licence status throughout the date range provided – each occurrence of this happening is included. An example of this is where a licence holder has been considered for suspension, then moved to suspension, then revoked. The provided figures would include all three status changes.

The total figures provided includes Individual, Dealer and Visitor licence holders.

We are unable to report on the licence status of the individual at the time the offending occurred due to how the data is recorded in NIA. The licence holder may be revoked when the data is extracted from NIA, but at the time of the offence, was, for example, temporarily suspended or current. It is not possible to identify what the licence status was of an individual at the time of offending due to how the data is recorded in NIA.

These figures capture all firearms licence status changes; therefore, it will include offences that occurred between the time of a licence suspension and the licence being revoked for a licence holder. An example of this is where a licence holder is suspended in 2021, offended in 2022, and then was suspended in 2023, with no further offending recorded. This individual would be recorded as coming to Police attention for the offending that occurred after the 2021 suspension.

Police interactions are recorded in NIA, with a specific offence code applied to the occurrence. The total figures capture offences with codes between 1000 and 9000 and is based on the individuals link to the occurrence. The link types used were 'Subject of', 'Offender', 'Cleared Offender', or 'Suspect.' A cleared offender is where an individual has had charges laid in relation to an offence, and they have been received by the courts.

Family harm incidents are included and identified by 5F code and where the individual is linked as either 'Bound by order', 'Mutual Participant', 'Predominant Aggressor', or 'Subject of.'

Occurrences are included regardless of their status, the outcome of the investigation, if charges were laid and the outcome of those charges. Included in these figures are individuals that have come to police attention for offending and have since been cleared of any criminal activity at a later date, those linked incorrectly, or where the wrong link type has been selected.

The date of the offending is based on the occurrence start date as recorded in NIA. This includes all occurrences where the start date is between 1 July 2021 and 31 December 2025. As an individual may have multiple police interactions, all occurrences are captured.

Table one includes only licence holders where any offending has occurred after the date of revocation, suspension, or referral to Resolutions for consideration of suspension. The count is a distinct count of Person therefore a licence holder will only appear once in the below table, even if there have been multiple revocations, suspensions, or offending.

Please refer to the attached document 'Table two Total licence holders subject to a suspension or revocation with subsequent offending by Offence code' for a breakdown of the offending. Included in the table are the following counts:

- a. **Count of offences:** This is a distinct count of occurrence ID therefore a licence holder may appear more than once if there have been multiple offences.
- b. **Count of people:** This is a distinct count of Person ID therefore a licence holder will only be counted once against each code, even if there have been multiple offences under the same code.
- c. **Sum of offences:** This is the sum of the count of offences. An individual will be counted for each individual offence.

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- d. **Distinct people total:** This is an overall distinct count of Person ID therefore a licence holder will only be counted once in the total even if there have been multiple offences. This total will not equal the sum of the count of people.

Please also advise whether Te Tari Pūreke or NZ Police currently tracks or measures post-intervention outcomes of regulatory actions.

Te Tari Pūreke and Police do not currently measure post-intervention outcomes of regulatory actions.

On 29th January 2026, you had refined the second part of your request to

Any internal reviews, evaluations, or formal performance assessments specifically relating to the effectiveness of Te Tari Pūreke's regulatory activities or the Firearms Registry in achieving public safety outcomes,

- *Produced between 1 January 2024 and 31 December 2025,*
- *That were provided to senior leadership (e.g. Commissioner, Deputy Commissioners, Assistant Commissioners), Police Executive, the Minister of Police, or Ministerial Services.*

This includes documents that discuss strengths, limitations, gaps in data, measurement challenges, or uncertainties about whether regulatory interventions are reducing risk or harm.


I am not seeking all operational reporting, dashboards, or routine metrics, but rather higher-level evaluative or analytical material

The Registry is currently part way through its rolling five-year implementation programme and will not be fully established until 31 August 2028. Once fully established, the purpose of the Registry is to provide Te Tari Pūreke and Police with a complete record of all lawfully held arms items in New Zealand. This will support efforts to prevent the diversion of firearms to organised criminal groups, enhance the safety of frontline Police staff, and give licence holders increased confidence when buying and selling arms items.

Due to the ongoing work required to fully establish the Registry, and the anticipated upcoming changes to Te Tari Pūreke following the introduction of the Arms Act, we have not yet undertaken an evaluation or review of the effectiveness of our regulatory activities or the Registry in achieving public safety outcomes. Accordingly, this part of your request is refused under section 18(e) of the OIA, as the documents you have requested do not exist.

These summaries outline the activities we undertake to ensure only individuals assessed to be fit and proper have legitimate access to firearms; how we proactively engage, educate and encourage regulated parties, stakeholders and partner to understand their firearms obligations to ensure safe possession and use; and how we work with other agencies to reduce the scope for people to conduct unlawful behaviour.

The Ministry of Justice undertook a review of the Firearms Registry between July and October 2024 to determine whether it is, or will, effectively improve public safety in accordance with the Terms of Reference previously approved by Cabinet. This included considering input from data, information and insights from key stakeholder groups such



as the Minister's Arms Advisory Group, Firearms Community Advisory Forum, Dealer's Reference Group, the Arms Engagement Group and the Muslim Reference Group. This review found that early indications show the Registry contributes to public safety¹.

On 10 February 2025 we partially transferred this part of your request to the Ministry of Justice for any information they hold.

You have the right to ask the Ombudsman to review this decision if you are not satisfied with the response to your request. Information about how to make a complaint is available at: www.ombudsman.parliament.nz.

For your information, Police has developed a process for proactive release of information, so the anonymised response to your request may be publicly released on the New Zealand Police website.
